1) Approval of minutes – Secretary Rose Chaney

2) Treasurer's Report – Treasurer Dave Wallace

The CLA Treasurer's report as of November 11 and the CLA Profit and Loss Statement from January 1 through November 11, 2007 are attached. The Board agreed to extend the General Fund CD in the amount of \$2770.06 for 90 days as no immediate expenses in excess of the funds in the regular bank account are anticipated.

3) Membership Report – Sonia Gladish

It was reported that the Association membership has not changed since the last meeting: currently there are 101 paid memberships for 2007.

4) Committee reports:

Finance Committee - Fred Vincent

The Finance Committee has prepared the Third Annual Lake Management Fund Letter which will be sent out to all Members and other parties interested in improving and protecting Cocolalla Lake. The letter was presented to the Board for review. Any comments should be submitted to the Finance Committee by November 21. The Finance Committee plans to send the Fund letter before December 1.

Lake Host Site Report – Chuck Gladish:

The Lake Host project construction has been completed. IDF&G plans to plant grass where the soil has been disturbed; because of cold weather they may to wait until spring

to complete this. Bryan Helmich reported that when the well was pumped there was some sand in the water. He felt it needed to be pumped for a longer period of time to see if the water clears. He will keep us informed of their progress on providing water to the site.

Land Use Report: Larry Erickson, Chairman

Committee member Nancy Cambron sent a report that she had reviewed the Bonner County Commissioners Agenda for the month and found no activities which affected Cocolalla Lake.

Newsletter: Glen Weatherly

Preparation for the newsletter will begin in a week or two.

Algae test report: Cary Poston

Status of UPS Claim for Damaged Algae Sample: UPS called asking for another damage claim request for payment. The claim request was faxed to them and they said the "check is in the mail."

IDA Milfoil Grant for 2007 – Cary Poston

All grant expenses have been paid. The IDA does not release the final 10% of the grand funds until they receive the "Final Grant Report" at the end of November. At that time CLA will be reimbursed approximately \$6,868 for funds advanced to pay contractors who worked on the Lake Host project. Total IDA Grant award for 2007 was \$72,296. CLA cash match will total approximately \$8,354. IDF&G contributed \$ 6,178.00 toward the project and Northern Lights contributed the cost of the electrical connection to the site.

CLA members have committed to 1000 In-Kind matching hours for the 2007 grant. If you have worked on the grant and have not submitted your time; please send your hours to <u>trchaney@nctv.com</u> or mail them to the Association mailbox before the 20th of this month so they can count towards the grant.

On October 31, Cary Poston and Rose Chaney met with the IDA Financial Review Committee. The Committee examined the CLA Grant documents for 2006 and 2006. The examiner said CLA passed the review with "flying colors".
