The meeting was called to order at 7:00PM with the Pledge of Allegiance.

1. Approval of Minutes for September 23rd meeting: Fred Vincent moved to approve the minutes. Cinda Bennett seconded the motion. All Approved.

Reports:

1. Treasurers Report: CLA has a net balance of \$44,655.67. There is \$546 due to SVS Testing and we brought in \$143 for maps. See Treasurers report attached.
2. Membership report: We have 83 members and 1 renewal. We had a discussion about marketing for new members and ways we can supplement the outgo for Lake Host position.
3. Water Quality report: The inspection took place this week. The algae bloom seems to be coming and going in several areas. This bloom was not as catastrophic as expected. Overall the water is good for this time of year.
4. Curly Leaf/EWM report: Kim Holzer and her crew went out on the lake Sept. 21st for our 3rd and final inspection for the year. They raked in several areas of interest but found no signs of either invasive species.
5. Water Level report: The water level is at 4.4. a little higher than last month..
6. Lake Host Position:
Bob Brimmer's Report: " This is my fifth year to check boats at the Cocolalla Launch, and I have enjoyed the entire time. I particularly have enjoyed working with the neighbors across the street from the office. The permanent tenants have said that if there was anything I needed
