Curly Leaf and EWM invasives updates/observations: The new representatives from ISDA Paul Rhoades (invasive species) and Jenny Roman (noxious weeds) will be working with us replacing Kim Holzer. The

inspection for Curly Leaf will be in late May. Milfoil will be inspected late June or early July.

Water Level Report/Beaver Dam: The water level is at 6.30. Any decisions the beaver dam removal is on hold for approval of a permit to move forward.

Lake Host Station report/funding recruitment: There will be a roving team this year but no report on days yet. The roving team has been funded, but implementation is dependent on hiring qualified personnel.

Fred checked with the post office with the possibility of putting an advertisement for membership to CLA. The manager said he would Ok our brochure in a small size.

Kathie will put a notice on Facebook to join our Association.

Corey suggested a 1 mile swim on the lake prior to the Long Bridge Swim. Fred will check on that because he knows some property owners practice for the Long Bridge Swim in front of his property. More discussion will take place at the May meeting

We will advertise for lake hosts at RV centers etc. We would like someone who can bring a camper or RV. Our pad can accommodate 2 units. Their rent would be free. Details in May.
