The Cocolalla Lake Association is dedicated to the enhancement of Lake Cocolalla and to retaining it's beauty for future generations. Since 1984, the Mission Statement of the CLA has been "To halt and reverse the eutrophication process occurring in Cocolalla Lake." This is accomplished by the dedicated efforts of many people in the community and also by various State and Federal agencies, including the Idaho Department of Fish and Game and the Federal Department of Environmental Quality. In recent years Eurasian Water Milfoil and algae blooms have become a serious problem, efforts made by the CLA have been instrumental in reducing these and other invasive species and the ensuing destructive effects. A healthy lake environment provides ideal conditions for the recreational enjoyment of the lake and fosters the growth of native flora and fisheries.

The association Board of Directors meets on the fourth Thursday of each month, March through October, at the Cocolalla Community Club House located near the south end of the Cocolalla Loop Road. The meetings start promptly at 7:00 pm, our meetings are informative and open to all members and the public. At the meetings lake quality reports of monthly inspections are presented by DEQ, and our volunteer Citizen Scientists. Any new conditions or events are called to the Boards attention and appropriate action can be decided upon. We frequently have guests, including Department of Fish and Game, State Department of Water Resources, Bonner County Emergency Management.
